

Dietitian Job Description

Duties and Responsibilities:

Work with Good News patients to provide individualized counseling regarding dietary needs

- Assess patient's current nutritional state and education need

- Provide diet specific information regarding their diagnosis

- Develop educational materials as needed

Work closely with providers to address any specific concerns regarding their patients

Conduct monthly educational classes on proper nutrition and healthy eating habits

Work closely with CHF patients and providers during weekly CHF clinic

Oversees Patient Orientation classes and other educational classes scheduled

Collaborate with Georgia Mountain Food bank regarding prescriptive food boxes and Neighborhood Fresh fruits and vegetables

- Determine eligibility based on food insecurity questionnaire

- Monitor and distribute as appropriate

- Maintain statistics as required regarding specific health indicators (monthly reports submitted to the GMFB)

Collaborate with local non-profits and educational institutions to enhance services for Good News patients. (Jubilee Farm Board, UGA Extension Office (Food Talk Class))

Assist with grants data collection

Provide and coordinate staff events to increase attention to health and wellness

- Keep current on trends and advances in clinic care

- Maintain a prompt and consistent attendance record
