## **2012 Financial Annual Report** (continued from page 3) Calculated Value of Services

#### Value of Medical Services = \$2,083,426

Medical Services are performed by volunteer providers supported by volunteer staff and GNC staff. Value of services is calculated by total volunteer hours for physicians, physician assistants and nurse practitioners in addition to total hours for GNC staff nurse practitioners. This value of medical services also includes \$63,683 in outside medical services for procedures performed by physician specialists in their offices and eyeglasses provided to patients.

#### Value of Dental Services = \$1,251,942

Dental Services are performed by volunteer dentists and hygienists supported by GNC staff. Value of services has been determined by our volunteer dentists, based on charges for each procedure in an office setting.

#### Value of Health Access Services = \$20,396,437

Health Access Services are provided by a network of 200+ specialty physicians who see patients in their offices, as well as inpatient and outpatient services provided through Northeast Georgia Medical Center. Value of services determined based on charges for the services in a provider office or NGMC.

#### Value of Medications = \$6,126,588

Medications include prescription drugs supplied by pharmaceutical companies and samples.

Total Value of All Services = \$29,858,393



**Providing hope, health & healing... a Year in Review**October 2011 through September 2012

#### PATIENT SERVICES

- ► Provided access to care for more than **1,600 new patients**
- Served approximately 4,000 individuals
- Expanded services through the addition of Health Access and a network of 200+ specialty physicians and managed over 350 specialty care referrals each month
- ▶ Doubled patient education classes to an average of **12 per month**
- ► Increased community partners by 5 leading education classes: a podiatrist, physical therapist, certified dietitian, ophthalmologist and nurse practitioner with specialty in health education
- ► Provided more than **12,700 volunteer hours**

#### PATIENT EDUCATION

- ▶ 1104 patients attended diabetes management, nutrition and/or tobacco cessation classes
- **78**% of patients attending classes showed improved health status in at least one area (blood pressure, cholesterol, or BMI)
- ▶ 81% of patients responding to a survey several months after attending classes reported at least one healthy lifestyle change made as recommended


