JOB DESCRIPTION FOR NURSE PRACTITIONER

- 1. Provides anticipatory guidance, screening, health education to patients to promote and maintain health.
- 2. Evaluates data obtained through a systematic approach to history taking and physical assessment. Initiates treatment for patients within the nurse practitioner's scope of practice and protocol agreement. Consult with supervising physician as needed.
- 3. Perform comprehensive health assessment including obtaining a complete and accurate health history from the patient or significant other; performing a complete and/or problem focused and accurate physical examination; and administering selected measures of physical, cognitive and psychosocial testing in accordance with standardized guidelines.
- 4. Order/ perform selected diagnostic test and procedures as indicated by patient's identified health problem.
- 5. Interprets clinical findings and diagnostic findings to develop a complete and accurate differential diagnoses/ health care problem list.
- 6. Identifies and uses available resources in meeting health care and educational needs of the patients, including by not limited to consultation with other medical providers and allied health professionals.
- 7. Plans appropriate care utilizing community resources and acts as a liaison by relaying information necessary for continuity of care to other health professionals and health agencies.
- 8. Prescribes, coordinates, delegates and evaluate care.
- 9. Instructs patients about health or defined health problems
- 10. Prepare all documentation of patient encounters, including communication with other providers regarding care of patient to include timeliness, legibility, accuracy, content and signature.
- 11. Participates in quality assurance activities
- 12. Participates in obtaining data for grant requirements.
- 13. Serves as preceptor for students rotating in the clinic.
- 14. Promotes guest relations; anticipates and responds to the needs of others; provides assistance in a courteous and quick manner; treats others with care and respect maintaining privacy, confidentiality and dignity, in accordance with HIPPA guidelines
- 15. Adheres to the mission, values and vision of Good News Clinics.
- 16. Maintains a professional appearance and a clean safe environment.
- 17. Other duties as assigned.
- 18. Serves as resource to clinical staff. Participates in identifying learning needs to promote quality care.
