Last week we received a call from a donor who has faithfully supported The Clinics since our inception 30 years ago. This donor has a friend who is suffering. The friend has found herself stripped of everything she once had. She fell prey to an abusive man and now, decades later, after much suffering, she is homeless, living in a local shelter. This promising woman's heritage, master's degree, and intellect could not save her from the dangers of this world. Having lost all stability, she is now rebuilding her life.

Dr. Sam Poole, one of the many founders of The Clinics said, "We will all suffer, we all have pain, but when we are poor it is tragically worse." He left a tremendous mark. Dr. Poole not only left a mark on his patients, but on our mission by ensuring our course was set on value-based care long before it was a health buzzword. We focus not just on getting patients well but keeping them from becoming unwell. We believe that a high-touch, deeply personal, and comprehensive medical practice brings about best outcomes for patients. Dr. Poole and his counterparts, then and now, have embodied that awareness. That is why they volunteer and why they freely, gladly answer the call of Jesus in Luke 12, "From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked."

This lovely, broken woman sat in the Good News Clinics dispensary being counseled by the same pharmacist who worked alongside Dr. Poole 20 years ago, not only about her medications, but about the hope Jesus Christ freely offers her; she who is not beyond repair, who can be healed, who will be made whole.

Annual reports are designed to share information, data, fiscal year budgets and volume reports. We are proud of our annual report because it is the measure of our value and service to this community. But, as you read, remember that each and every number, every good outcome and dollar accounted for, is but a way of measuring love, good news for the poor, and hope in peoples' lives.

As we look back, we also look forward. Our Greater Things Campaign report is enclosed and as we prepare to break ground for expanded capacity in early spring of 2023, we do so because of the growing number of patients who need us. We do so with your blessing and support and with our volunteers' incredible passion for making sure no one falls through the cracks.

May God guide, compel, and bless all who are poor, through you and through us, that they and we may indeed have the Kingdom of Heaven here, now, and forever.

Patient Stories

Our patients are the heart of what we do. With your support, Good News Clinics provides medical, dental, vision, and mental healthcare to those who might otherwise go without it. When patients leave our clinics with the prescriptions, education, and information they need to live a healthier life, our entire community grows stronger and thrives.



DONALD

Donald "Duck" is a quiet man fighting for his life. A hereditary condition of Congestive Heart Failure (CHF) was discovered when he collapsed at his job and was sent to the hospital. When he was told that he could no longer work, he not only lost his job, but he also lost his health benefits. During his follow-up appointment at the Gainesville Heart Center, Duck was referred to Good News Clinics for continued treatment. Duck shared that, "Eva Johnson is helping me and the medications I get are keeping me alive." When asked about the impact the Clinics have made on his daily life, Duck replied, "I'm not blacking out anymore, and I can breathe". Sonja Gordon, Duck's friend, commented, "The doctors here [at the Clinics] are the best, and they have helped Duck when no one else would."



ALMA

In 2019, while hospitalized for pneumonia, Alma was diagnosed with Congestive Heart Failure (CHF) with an ejection fraction of only 20%. Years of trauma, addiction, poor nutrition, and smoking caused damage to her heart. When she was discharged from the hospital, she was referred to Good News Clinics for care in our CHF program, beginning her journey to better health and recovery.

Alma beams with gratitude for the medical care and friendship she has found among the staff at the Clinics, crediting them with enrolling her in a smoking cessation class, teaching her how to eat nutritiously, and providing her with proper medications and treatment to manage her heart condition; she is proud to report that her ejection fraction has improved to 55%. Although Alma works as a part-time caregiver, she does not have health insurance and is grateful to receive care at the Clinics. "This place is such a blessing. God has been good to me and so has Good News Clinics."



CHRISTOPHER

Christopher "Chris" was referred to the Clinics by North Georgia Works for medical and dental care in June 2022. Although Chris has worked for the last 3 years installing industrial water pipes and storm and sewer drains, he hasn't been able to afford insurance. "I've never been able to afford getting my teeth fixed, and it's been since high school that I've been to a dentist." He appreciates the kindness of the staff and dentists he has encountered here. "I've told the guys at North Georgia Works about the great care I've received and that they should come check it out. I'm also a patient in the medical clinic, and Dr. Henson is nice." Asked about the need for Good News Clinics in the community, Chris said, "There are good people out there who need help but can't afford it without the care that Good News Clinics provides."




